Table Set:

1. God calls us to be stewards of HIS property - this earth and everything in it. How is being a steward different than owning something? What attitude towards God do we betray when we steal what belongs to someone else? Why would God be grieved by us stealing?
2. Read Psalm 62:10. What do you think is the underlying root emotion of stealing? Read Ephesians 4:28. Give some examples of modern day stealing that go beyond simply taking someone else's physical property (consider time, joy, talents, etc...). How else, or what else, do we steal? Does this verse tell us it is enough only to cease from sin or do you think that God requires more to a repentant heart? If more, what would this look like?
3. How does knowing God owns everything and has a purpose for everything change your attitude about how tightly you hold to things or your willingness to share more readily? What are some practical ways to share with those in need? Consider doing a one-time small group outreach to share with someone in need.
