### Intensive Study Questions

1. Read John 18:1-14.

3. Reread the John 18:14. What is the irony in Caiaphas' statement?
4. List the I AM Statements from the Book of John (Hint: Many of the lecture titles).
5. What is the significance of the words Jesus says to the soldiers, "I AM" he? Find an Old Testament Example of I AM used to describe God. (Hint: Exodus 3:14)
6. Read John 3:16-18. Discuss together the meaning of this verse.
7. Read Romans 8:1-2. Discuss together the meaning of this verse.
8. What are some Christmas traditions that you have that focus on Jesus?
9. Evaluate some of your Christmas traditions and preparations. What percentage do you feel encourage you and others to reflect on the life of Jesus? As a result of your evaluation, do you need to make some changes? What might those be?
