8. Name three specific ways you are handing off the Baton.

2. What are some rewards you have experienced from relationships? What do these rewards teach us about God?
3. Describe a time when you experienced the "reality of relationships". How did Paul deal with those realities? How can we specifically plan and deal with those realities?
4. What does the story of Mark teach us about reconciliation and redemption in relationships? Do you have any relationships that are in need of reconciliation and redemption? How could your Bible Study Group help you to deal with those relationships?
5. Paul asked Timothy to bring him a few key items. What are some key items you would request in a similar situation? Do any of these relate to your faith?
6. We are running a relay, to whom are you handing off the Baton? Name three specific ways you are handing off the Baton.
