Ice Breaker:

Do you have a “prayer closet?” Tell us about it.

Question Set:

1. What are some barriers that prevent the development of prayer partners in our lives? As a group, name some ways we might be able to overcome these barriers.
2. Look again at Daniel 14-23. What did Daniel tell his friends to seek? How might appealing to God’s character first rather than petitioning for our desires improve our prayers? What is the first thing Daniel did in response to God’s answer? What does he praise God for (see if you can find 7)? If we were to match our persistence in prayer with prayers of gratitude for God’s answers, what impact would this have on our prayer life? Why? Compare Hezekiah’s prayer for deliverance in 2 Kings 19:14-19 to Daniel’s approach to prayer for deliverance. How are they similar or different? Does anything in particular strike you concerning their prayer requests? What is their hope in the outcome of deliverance?
3. Throughout the book of Daniel, we see Daniel demonstrate a lifestyle of prayer. What are some things you could do to improve your prayer-life? Commit to one of those this week and be accountable to your group or to someone in your group for following through with it.

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
