**Study Questions for November 1, 2017**  
**Holiness in Difficulty ~ 1 Peter 1:1-2:3 ~ Juli Fischer**

1. Read the portion of scripture a few times for this week. Reading the whole book is also a great idea, but at least read the portion for this week. While you are reading think about what God is doing, what God is like, what is taught about God, what pleases God, or basically what you are learning about God? Write those down.

- Example: God the Father has foreknowledge of us. (2)

2. Verses 3 - 12 of chapter 1 start out the letter with a reminder of their salvation. All of the points in these verses are under the umbrella of salvation. There are many! List as many as you can.

3. Living hope! Amazing! Hope seems to be put in a category that is different from everyday hope. What do we learn about hope in these verses? Psalm 39:7, Proverbs 10:18, Romans 5:5, 1 Corinthians 13:13, Ephesians 1:18  
Where is our hope kept? What do you hope for?

4. Read verses 10 - 12. What do we learn about the prophets in the Old Testament?

5. How are we to be holy in verses 13 through 2:3? Read Leviticus 20: 7 and 26. Why are we to be holy? Or what should be our motive?

6. In verses 17 - 21 God has two identifications. What are they? Which one do you identify with?

7. What words are used a few times in these verses (and I don't mean the or and or are or is!) Why does Peter use them often?
