1. This question requires a concordance in the back of a study Bible or go to [biblestudytools.com](http://biblestudytools.com) (or other Bible websites). Look up "goodness" or "good" and then read the verses. For the next question look up Job (the person) and see where he is mentioned besides the book of Job.
2. What does the Bible say about the goodness of God?
3. What other verses in other books of the Bible mention Job? What is said about him?
4. Read this passage over several times. What did you learn about God?
5. Describe the tragedies that occurred in verses 14 through 19. If you were Job at this time what sort of temptations would you have to struggle with? Why are multiple tragedies so difficult to handle? 1 Corinthians 10:13 says what?
6. What did you learn about Satan in these verses?
7. Job's reaction to his suffering is common and worshipful. What lessons do we learn about suffering from Job's responses?
8. What have been or are some of your sufferings? Have you experienced multiple hardships at the same time? Do you remember your reaction?
9. What is your prayer after studying these verses?
