In a similar way, maybe your head is spinning a bit with how quickly the pace of John has changed. Where the first 12 chapters covered nearly three years time, and most weeks we looked at one chapter per week, chapters 13-19 span only about 24 hours and we're gobbling up 2-3 chapters at a time.
