Dear Friends,

Today we are looking at a story about Jesus healing a man born blind, from John chapter 9. It is a great illustration of his statement in chapter 8 last week: "I am the Light of the World." Because we are covering both chapter 9 and 10 this week, please remember to have your Bibles open to the passage during the lecture because there are too many verses to display on the screens.

Chapter 10 contains two more of Jesus' seven "I am' statements from the gospel of John. We have already heard Jesus state "I am the bread of life" (John 6:35), and "I am the light of the world (John 8:12). This week in chapter 10 he says "I am the gate" (John 10:7) and "I am the good shepherd" (John 10:11,14). The remaining three are "I am the resurrection and the life" (John 11:25); "I am the way and the truth and the life" (John 14:6) and "I am the true vine" (John 15:1). These are meant to give us a clearer picture of who Jesus is and what he does. I hope we can walk away from John 9-10 with a greater understanding of why Jesus picked "the gate" and "the good shepherd" to describe his work on earth.
