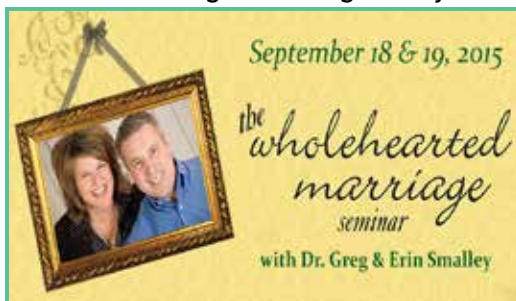

THE GRAND ILLUSION

AS WE HAVE RECENTLY READ IN THE PRESS, the Ashley Madison website - which connects married people who want to have an extramarital affair - was hacked and nearly 37 million email addresses were leaked. Think about it: **37 million. An untold number of families will break apart.**

In 2000, a good friend of mine and groomsman in my wedding was in a very serious car accident and became a quadriplegic. His wife has stood by him for 15 years in a very difficult situation that most of us can't begin to imagine. What a contrast to Ashley Madison!

Love and hate (or perhaps worse, indifference), good and evil are real. As I go about my daily life in an environment of professional courtesy and "Minnesota nice," and interact with people who appear to have no spiritual need, it is easy to get lulled into thinking I am living in some type of moral neutral zone, void of the battle of good and evil. **It is a grand illusion.** I need only to look at the battle in my own soul to realize nothing could be further from the truth.

It is in the midst of this battle, we are called to be salt and light. Not to the church, but to the world. As is written: *"You are the light of the world. A city on a hill cannot be hidden.... In the same way, let your light shine before others."* *"And he has committed to us the message of reconciliation. We are therefore Christ's ambassadors, as though God were making his appeal through us."* (Matthew 5: 14,16; 2 Corinthians 5: 19, 20)

May the Spirit of God give us sensitivity to discern the battle we are in and the wisdom to be the ambassadors we are.

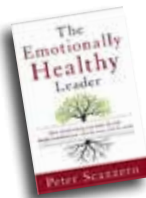
