INSPIRING VISION

When God told Abraham a great nation would come from him, he said, "Look at the stars and number them, if indeed you can count them...So shall your offspring be." Imagine Abraham every night gazing at the stars, remembering that inspiring vision God gave him. He gained purpose and strength from it as he followed in obedience to God.

Maybe you have followed a vision. Perhaps your career choice came from inner passion and vision to make a difference in this world. Jesus has given all believers in him a mission. At Autumn Ridge Church, we frame it this way: "We make disciples of Jesus Christ who love God and serve people."
